## What is the IME Video Library?

The Innovations in Medical Education (IME) Video Library is a **Web-based resource** which offers free, high quality, streaming videos of educational events that have taken place at the University of Wisconsin (UW) Health Sciences Learning Center (HSLC).

## Why was a video library created?

The UW School of Medicine and Public Health (SMPH) is a state-wide campus with educational sites in many communities. The Video Library allows the entire educational network, and the public, access to the presentations from remote locations.

The IME Video Library is a component of outreach at the UW SMPH. IME is supported by a grant from the Wisconsin Partnership Program.

## Who can access the Video Library?

All presentations are open to the public through a simple (no cost) sign in. Key users include:

- Health sciences faculty, staff and students
- Community preceptors
- Public health organizations
- Health consumers

## What else can I expect to find?

- Biographies of the presenters
- Research links selected by health sciences librarians
- A downloadable audio only version of the presentations – MP3s
- Notification features such as: Email and RSS feeds

## How are events captured?

Presentations at the HSLC are captured using digital in-house, wall-mounted cameras and wireless microphones. The digital video files are uploaded, edited and stored on a streaming server for viewing. All presentations are captured with written permission from the presenters.

## What software do I need to view these presentations?

Videos are either in a Windows Media or QuickTime format. Both players are available as free downloads.
